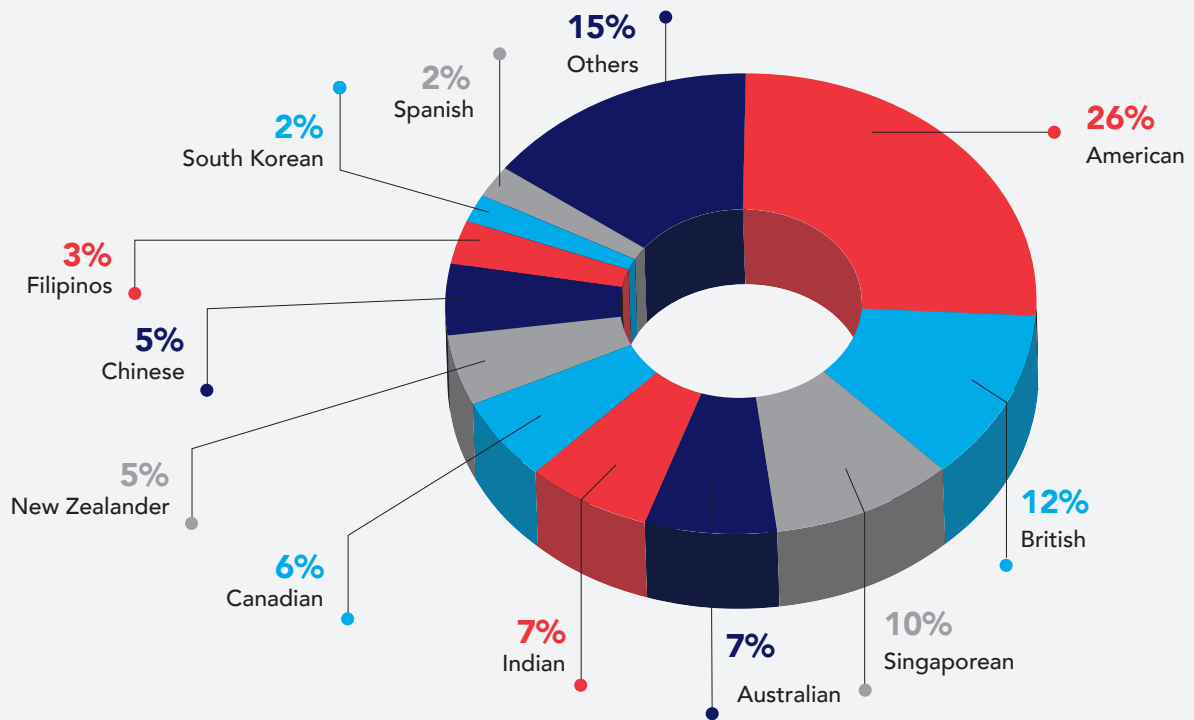

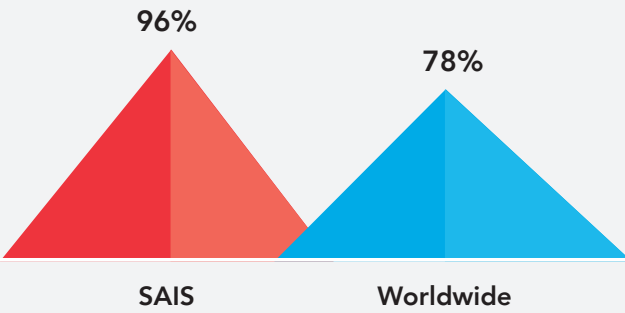

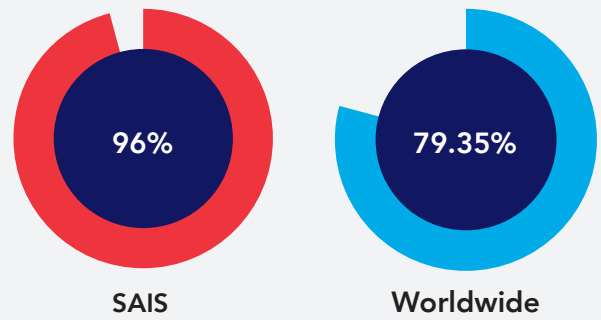
PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ACHIEVING BILINGUAL DIPLOMA
