ACADEMIC COURSE OFFERINGS

IBDP, BTEC and Stamford Courses are offered to students in Grades 11 to 12. AP courses are offered to students from Grades 10 to 12. Stamford American students are limited to taking a maximum of 4 advanced courses per year (AP and IB HL courses). IBDP students are restricted to three Higher Level courses.

PREPARATORY COURSE FOR SECONDARY (PCS)

Grade 6 to 10 students who are English Language Learners may join Stamford American by first attending our intensive Preparatory Course for Secondary (PCS), in order to improve their academic English to meet the rigor of the secondary curriculum. Students may study either one or two semesters within PCS before graduating into their appropriate Grade level program.

GRADES 9 & 10 - IB MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (IB MYP)


All students in Grades 9 and 10 are enrolled in the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP), as a part of the IB Continuum at Stamford American. As MYP students, our Grade 10 students have the option to pursue an IB-validated MYP Certificate, individual MYP Course Certificates, or MYP Flexi with Certificate by sitting in an AP course. This allows students to continue learning in the MYP while beginning to explore options for flexible pathway options in Grades 11 and 12. Throughout the programme our students engage in contexts and approaches to learning as a tool for academic success.

GRADES 11 & 12 (IB DP OR INDIVIDUALIZED PATHWAY)

Academic counseling begins for students in Grade 9. Students in Grades 11 and 12 have the option to pursue the full IB Diploma or an individualized academic pathway. Stamford American is the first and only school in Singapore to concurrently offer the American Advanced Placement, BTEC International Level 3 and International Baccalaureate Diploma Curricula.

INDIVIDUALIZED PATHWAY

Stamford American students have the opportunity to take a blend of IB, BTEC, AP and/or Stamford Courses to work towards the Stamford High School Diploma. This offers flexibility and choice for students in the content and rigor of their programs of study. Students in the individualized pathway may also choose to take external IB or AP examinations. Students in the BTEC Diploma are more restricted to the courses they may take depending on the type of BTEC diploma they are working towards.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Total minimum credits to graduate is 24 credits + Service: 1 credit equals 1 academic year of study.

The majority of students will graduate in excess of the minimum graduation requirements. Students may not graduate early even if all credits are met.

STAMFORD GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) EQUIVALENCY

Students at Stamford American are not ranked, nor do we calculate GPA. For schools requiring GPA we suggest the following equivalency: students taking IBDP Standard Level (SL) and Theory of Knowledge (TOK) courses would be awarded a 0.5 weight per semester. Students taking IBDP Higher Level (HL) and AP courses would be awarded a 1.0 weight per semester. These weightings represent the rigor of the courses.

GRADING AND REPORTING


Progress grades are reported semesterly, and only final year grades are reported on the transcript. Stamford American uses the IB 1-7 grading scale for Stamford, PCS, MYP and DP courses, the 1-5 scale for AP courses, and the BTEC D*-U scale for BTEC courses for BTEC courses. Theory of Knowledge is reported as a P (Pass) or F (Fail), as we want the focus to be on feedback and student learning. Due to the semester-based program within PCS, students graduating after only one semester of study will receive 0.5 credit per course. If they join the High School for the second semester, then they can earn 0.5 credit per course within the MYP program.

IBDP RESULTS | CLASS OF 2024

IB Diploma candidates must also complete the IBDP Core, which consists of Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS), and the Extended Essay (EE). Stamford HS Diploma students can choose to pursue IBDP Course Certificates, enabling them to sit selected IBDP examinations and not complete the Extended Essay.
